Notice to Bidders

Rehabilitation of Duanesburg Churches Road over S. Chuctanunda Creek

Notice is hereby given that the County of Schenectady will be accepting sealed bids for a Bridge Rehabilitation Project located on Duanesburg Churches Road in the Town of Duanesburg. The project consists of the installation of a new concrete invert, the rehabilitation of the corrugated concrete roof and walls, replacement of the existing rail system, and the removal of the silt within the culvert.

This is a Federal-Aid project and Federal requirements will prevail. Subcontracting is permitted as described in Section 108-05 of the Standard Specifications of the New York State Department of Transportation.

Plans are available for viewing at the Schenectady County Purchasing Department, 620 State Street, 6th Floor, Schenectady, NY 12305. Digital plans and specifications may be obtained at the Empire State Purchasing Group website, <http://www.empirestatebidsystem.com>, or by submitting an email request to purchasing@schenectadycounty.com. Printed copies may be requested from purchasing@schenectadycounty.com but require 24 hours advance notice.

All sealed bids must be delivered to the Schenectady County Director of Purchasing located at 620 State Street, 6th Floor, Schenectady, NY 12305. Bids must be delivered in a sealed envelope annotated with the project name, not later than **11:00 AM, July 20, 2017** at which time they will be opened and publicly read. Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

Woman and minority owned bidders are encouraged to submit proposals. Schenectady County is an Equal Employment Opportunity / Affirmative Action employer. The right is reserved to reject any and all proposals or any part thereof. Goals: Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal (DBE): 0%; Minority Business Subcontracting Goal: 0%; Women-owned Business Subcontracting Goal: 0%.

The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded will be required to furnish Performance, Payment and Guarantee Bonds from an acceptable Surety Company for an amount not less than 100% of the accepted bid.

Schenectady County reserves the right to consider the bids for forty-five (45) days after receipt before awarding any Contract, and to waive any informalities in, and to reject, any and all bids or to accept the one that in its judgment will be for the best interest of the County. All bids are subject to final review and approval by the Schenectady County Department of Engineering and Public Works Director of Engineering before any award of contract may be made. Receipt of bids by the County shall not be construed as authority to bind the County.
