

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR FACILITY ACCESS?

A valid 2017 permit card is required for all services.

WHO CAN USE THE YARD TRIMMINGS COMPOSTING FACILITY?

Any residential customer and commercial hauler with a valid 2017 permit.

WHO CAN USE THE RECYCLING FACILITY?

Any residential customer with a valid 2017 permit. NO business or commercial operations.

HOW SHOULD MATERIALS BE BROUGHT TO THE FACILITY?

All loose materials should be inside the vehicle or covered.

BULK ITEM RECYCLING AND ELECTRONICS DISPOSAL PROGRAM

Bulk item recycling is also available at the Composting & Resident Recycling Facility. Items such as appliances, furniture, and tires can be accepted (some items carry fees for disposal). Please see the Bulk Item/E-Waste Recycling Program brochure for information.

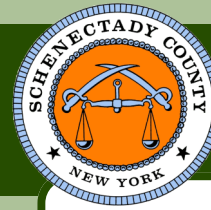
SPECIAL CONDITIONS

PERMIT INFORMATION & FEE SCHEDULE

A PERMIT CARD is required for all Schenectady County and out-of-county residential customers, in-county commercial haulers, and out-of-county commercial haulers in order to use the Composting & Resident Recycling Facility.

A valid vehicle registration is required to purchase the PERMIT CARD.

Schenectady County Resident and Commercial Fee is \$20

Out-of-County Resident and Commercial Fee is \$25.

CASH ONLY - CHECKS AND CREDIT CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

The PERMIT CARD is valid for the current calendar year (January 1 - December 31)

RESIDENT PERMIT CARD HOLDERS:

- PERMIT CARDS are marked on each visit for yard trimming disposal only, in 2 yard increments (*i.e., a 6 yard truck would represent three visits*)
- No more than 12 visits permitted per card
- When all 12 visits are marked on the PERMIT CARD, residents will be required to purchase a new card for yard trimming disposal.
- Unlimited visits are allowed for recyclables, bulk item, and electronic disposal.

FEE SCHEDULE FOR COMMERCIAL HAULERS

(*in addition to permit card fee*)

In-county haulers: \$7.00 per cubic yard

Out-of-county haulers: \$11.00 per cubic yard

REPLACEMENT CARDS (ALL PERMIT CARD HOLDERS)

NO REPLACEMENT CARDS WILL BE ISSUED. If you lose your permit card, you will be required to purchase another card for the full fee. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING FACILITY

Acceptable Materials for recycling

Glass bottles (green, clear, brown)
Juice boxes
Junk mail (including coupons)
Kraft paper
Magazines, catalogs, newspaper
Milk cartons
Notebook paper
Paper egg cartons
Paperback books
Plastic containers #1-7
Soft-cover workbooks
Telephone books
Tin & bi-metallic containers
White & colored ledger paper
White envelopes

NOT ACCEPTABLE

Aluminum items
(*other than those listed*)
Bottle caps or lids
Carbon paper
Clothing
Cookware
Diapers
Light bulbs
Mirrors
Pane glass
Plastic bags & liners
Styrofoam
Trash
Polystyrene



**ALL MATERIALS MUST BE EMPTY, CLEAN,
DRY, AND FREE OF CONTAMINATION**

YARD TRIMMING COMPOST FACILITY

Acceptable materials for composting

- Yard trimmings (loose): grass, leaves
- Yard trimmings (bagged): must be in biodegradable paper bags. NO plastic bags
- Logs & Stumps: Free of excess soil and rocks
- Brush: Any material exceeding 4 inches in diameter must be cut into 5-ft lengths
