

## Limited Visitation Plan for the Glendale Home

To ensure the safety of you, your loved one, and our staff, all visitors must follow the directives set forth by the NYS Department of Health. Please note the following guidelines listed below with visiting:

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- ❖ **Visitation** can be conducted in residents rooms, dedicated spaces and outdoor weather permitting. Regardless of how the visit is conducted, visitation will occur according to core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention and facility policies while using the Schenectady County positivity rate. The facility can accommodate up to 20% of daily census for visitors.
- ❖ **Screening** of all visitors will occur upon arrival for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, will be rapid tested and expect to wait for the results before visitation can commence. Visitation will be refused if the individual does not have proof of a negative COVID-19 test, exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening. Visitation will be refused if the individual does not have proof of a negative COVID-19 test, exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening.
- ❖ **Visitors must schedule an appointment** with the facility to visit a resident. Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult, 18 years of age or older. Each visit will have a maximum time of 60 minutes. Visitation area will be disinfected after each visit.
- ❖ **Outdoor visits** will take place outside in front of the building: weather permitting. Please pull into the driveway near the Glendale Home sign and check in at table. Visitation may be postponed in accordance to NYS Department of Health Skilled Nursing Facility Visitation Guidance.
- ❖ **To ensure the safety** of you, your loved one, and our staff, all visitors must follow the directives set forth by the NYS Department of Health. Visitors must adhere to following guidelines, infection prevention and control policies when visiting: Visitation will be refused if the individual refuses screening or to wear a mask. If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health

emergency. Staff will monitor visitors for those who may have difficulty adhering to our core principles ie: children.

- ❖ **During the visit**, visitors must wear a face mask over mouth and nose at all times. We will provide face masks to visitors who lack an acceptable face covering. Visitors must use alcohol-based hand sanitizer before and after the visit. A social distance of at least 6 feet between visitors and resident must be maintained at all times with no physical touching (hand holding, hugging, kissing, etc.) permitted. No food can be shared. Restrooms are not available for visitors. Visitors must go to the residents' room or designated visitation area. Visitors are not allowed to walk around different halls of the facility. Visits for residents who share a room will not be conducted in the residents' room unless the roommates are spouses.

To schedule a visit at The Glendale Home, please call 518-384-3609. Visitation hours will be held daily from 10 am-4 pm. Appointments can be made by logging on the Schenectady County website on the Glendale Home section. If you need to cancel your visit, please call (518) 384-3622 as soon as possible. *In the event of a case of COVID-19 in the facility, or a high (greater than 10%) positivity rate visitation will be suspended for at least 14 days.*
